- 1 Obtenha o endereço IP da impressora. Execute um dos seguintes procedimentos:
 - Localize o endereço IP na tela inicial da impressora.
 - Na tela inicial da impressora, toque em Configurações > Rede/Portas > Visão geral da rede.
- **2** Abra o navegador da Web e digite o endereço IP da impressora.

- 1 No Embedded Web Server, navegue até a página de configuração do aplicativo: Apps >Nome do aplicativo > Configurar.
- **2** Execute um dos seguintes procedimentos:

• Altere o texto do ícone e o ícone.

Na seção Tela inicial, especifique o texto e a imagem que você deseja que apareça na tela inicial.

- Configure as definições do aplicativo.
 - No campo Servidor de FileBound, digite o URL de FileBound.
 - No campo Nome de arquivo padrão, digite um nome de arquivo válido.

Nota: É possível inserir até 58 caracteres. Só são permitidos caracteres alfanuméricos, sublinhados, traços e espaços em branco.

- No campo Configurações de digitalização, selecione Mostrar ou Ocultar.
- No campo Formato de arquivo, selecione PDF ou TIFF.

Nota: Só são suportados formatos de arquivo PDF e TIFF.

3 Se for necessário, defina a conta padrão para iniciar sessão no FileBound.

Notas:

- Se estiver definida, a Conta padrão é utilizada para iniciar sessão no FileBound.
- Se não definir uma conta padrão, será necessário iniciar sessão toda vez que você entrar no aplicativo.
- 4 Clique em Aplicar.

Importação e exportação de um arquivo de configuração

Importar arquivos de configuração substitui as configurações existentes do aplicativo.

- Quando o arquivo de configuração é exportado, as senhas não são salvas. Defina a senha novamente depois de importar o arquivo.
- 1 No Embedded Web Server, navegue até a página de configuração do aplicativo:

Apps > Scan to FileBound > Configure

- Antes de iniciar, ative a digitalização no Embedded Web Server.
- A conta padrão é utilizada durante o lançamento do aplicativo.
- 1 Coloque um documento original na bandeja ADF ou no vidro do scanner.

Nota: Para obter mais informações, consulte o Guia do usuário da impressora.

- 2 Na tela inicial, toque no ícone do perfil do aplicativo.
- **3** Se solicitado, digite suas credenciais.
- 4 Selecione um projeto e toque em Avançar.

Notas:

- Se não tiver uma conta padrão, então você deverá inserir suas credenciais.
- Os projetos do servidor de FileBound estão listados em ordem alfabética e estão limitados nas primeiras 100 entradas.
- **5** Digite as informações (frase de procura) para procurar um arquivo e, em seguida, toque em **Procurar**.

Nota: A fase de procura deve ter um mínimo de 3 caracteres.

- **6** Selecione a partir dos resultados da pesquisa e pressione **Avançar**.
- **7** Se for necessário, selecione um separador e toque em **Avançar**.
- **8** Selecione um divisor e toque em **Avançar**.

Nota: Os divisores e separadores são limitados a 100 entradas.

9 Digite o nome do arquivo, a descrição e as notas (se necessário) e toque em Avançar.

Notas:

- O valor padrão do nome do arquivo é tomado a partir da definição do Nome de arquivo padrão na página de configuração.
- Os caracteres a seguir não são permitidos: " " # % & *:<>?/\{|}
- **10** Se necessário, ajuste as definições.

Nota: Se nenhum disco rígido de impressora estiver instalado, o tamanho máximo do arquivo será de 20 MB.

- **11** Toque em **Enviar**.
- **12** Envie o documento ou digitalize a próxima página.

Nota: Para verificar o documento carregado, entre no portal FileBound e procure o documento.

Erro de aplicativo

Tente uma ou mais das seguintes opções:

Verifique o log de diagnóstico

- 1 Abra o navegador da Web e digite *IP*/se, sendo que *IP* é o endereço IP da impressora.
- 2 Clique em Soluções embarcadas e faça o seguinte:
 - a Apague o arquivo de registro.
 - **b** Defina o nível de registro para **Sim**.
 - **c** Gere o arquivo de registro.
- **3** Analise o registro e solucione o problema.

Nota: para evitar problemas de memória insuficiente, depois de analisar o registro, defina o nível de registro em log como **Não**.
